#### **Articulation Criteria and Articulation Benefits**

# The articulation criteria ("Articulation Criteria") are:

- Completion of the Associate of Applied Science program in Criminal Justice Law Enforcement or Criminal Justice - Corrections degrees within the Wisconsin Technical College System. The degree must have been earned May 2006 or later.
- 2. Achieving a minimum overall cumulative grade point average of 2.0 on a 4.0 system.
- 3. Students must earn 128 semester credit hours and 43 upper division (300 and 400 level) credits to meet graduation requirements.
- 4. All transferred course work must have a grade of at least C.
- Graduates of the College pursuing the Criminal Justice degree must complete at least their last 30 credits at VU.
- 6. Graduates of the Wisconsin Technical College System pursuing the Criminal Justice in Law Enforcement or Corrections degrees must complete the following requirements for the core curriculum, major, and BS or BA degree as outlined in the catalog in which the student enters VU.

A Spanish Placement Exam is available for students who have taken Spanish in high school, been exposed to Spanish as a second language or who has lived in a Spanish speaking country for an extended period of time. Students will be placed into the appropriate Spanish course after the exam has been evaluated and results will be placed into the student's advising file or sent to the advisor. Students who complete the specified course with a C or above will receive from 4 to 14 credits of retroactive credit depending upon the course they completed. Students who have not taken any Spanish courses will be required to complete 14 credits of Spanish.
