



The Mid-State Technical College Foundation is pleased to announce the following scholarship opportunities for graduating high school seniors planning to attend MSTC's Marshfield, Stevens Point or Wisconsin Rapids campuses, or the Adams County Center full-time (12 credits or more) in Fall 2010.

Mid-State Technical College Foundation Scholarship – 25 @ \$1,250 for one year

Leonard & Lillian Bethke Transportation Scholarship – One full-tuition
(Up to \$6,000 over two years for Automotive Technician program students)

Francis & Evelyn Haines Scholarship – 2 @ \$500 for one year
(Granton or Neillsville High School graduates)

Application Procedures

1. Complete the admissions procedure for a full-time program at MSTC for enrollment in August 2010.
2. Attach a complete transcript of your high school records to include ACT scores (if taken) to the application.
3. Accuplacer, or college entrance exam test scores, must be submitted if ACT scores are not available.
4. All transcript GPAs **must** be calculated on a 4.0 scale to be eligible.
5. Check all scholarships for which you are applying and complete the necessary sections for each. These are located on the inside back cover of this application. Failure to do so may limit your eligibility for possible scholarship opportunities.
6. While applying for financial aid is not a requirement for receiving a scholarship, it is recommended you complete the 2010-11 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) form if you wish to have your scholarship application based on financial need. Applications are available online at www.fafsa.ed.gov.
7. Mail or deliver all completed forms to the MSTC Foundation Office, 500 32nd Street North, Wisconsin Rapids, WI 54494 by **Thursday, April 8**.

Selection Procedure

Recipients are selected by representatives of Mid-State Technical College based on completion of application form, essay responses, extracurricular activities in grades 9-12, test rank based on college entrance exam results, and/or grade point average.

Academic Standards

1. To remain eligible for continuation of scholarship after the initial semester, recipients must maintain a 2.5 GPA on a 4.0 scale, must be registered full-time (12 credits or more), and successfully complete 70% of the courses for which they register each semester.
2. Recipients must authorize Mid-State Technical College to release future transcripts to the MSTC Foundation Director, 500 32nd Street North, Wisconsin Rapids, WI 54494.
3. Recipients must remain in good disciplinary standing with Mid-State Technical College.

Deadline

The Mid-State Technical College Foundation must receive all scholarship applications by **Thursday, April 8**. All applicants will be notified by Monday, May 3, 2010 whether or not they have been selected for an MSTC Foundation Scholarship.
